- 1 WELCOME** **Anchorage Mile 127**
Welcome to Alaska! Listen to this track before leaving Anchorage.
- 2 POTTER MARSH** **Huffman Road Overpass Mile 120**
The boardwalk allows easy access to observe 100+ species of birds.
- 3 TURNAGAIN ARM** **Chugach Visitor's Center Mile 115**
English explorer Captain James Cook named Turnagain Arm in 1778.
- 4 FLORA AND FAUNA** **Bird Creek Bridge Mile 102**
In late summer, Beluga whales chase spawning salmon up the Arm.
- 5 GIRDWOOD** **Bird Point Mile 96**
This community offers restaurants, shops, and year-round activities.
- 6 PORTAGE GLACIER** **Alyeska Highway Junction Mile 90**
Over the past 100 years, the receding glacier has exposed Portage Lake.
- 7 WHITTIER** **Chugach Forest Sign Mile 86**
Whittier is the departure point for adventures in Prince William Sound.
- 8 1964 EARTHQUAKE** **Whittier/Portage Road Mile 80**
This 9.2 earthquake is one of the largest earthquakes ever recorded.
- 9 KENAI PENINSULA** **Welcome Sign Mile 75**
"Kenai" is from the Dena'ina Athabascan term "ken" meaning "flat land."
- 10 TURNAGAIN PASS** **Right Turnout Area Mile 69**
Here you can listen for the Hoary Marmot's high-pitched whistle.
- 11 GOLD RUSH** **Granite Creek Campground Mile 63**
The peak of the Turnagain Arm Gold Rush was between 1896-1898.
- 12 RAILS AND TRAILS** **Hope Highway Junction Mile 56**
The Alaska Railroad and the Iditarod Trail both begin in Seward.
- 13 AVALANCHES** **Avalanche Gates Mile 40**
In the winter, forecasters evaluate avalanche risk.
- 14 MOOSE PASS** **Fish Hatchery Mile 33**
This town was most likely named for one very stubborn moose.
- 15 KENAI LAKE** **Railroad Tracks Mile 24**
The Lake's milky appearance is from its glacial silt content.
- 16 RUSSIANS IN ALASKA** **Railroad Bridge Mile 14**
A Russian trader named Resurrection Bay for Easter Sunday.
- 17 EXIT GLACIER** **Chugach Forest Sign Mile 8**
The glacier's blue wall of ice looms high above the access trail.
- 18 SEWARD** **Exit Glacier Road Mile 4**
Welcome to Seward! This picturesque community sits on Resurrection Bay.
